SOUTH BOUND SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (I-405) AT TEMPLE AVENUE BRIDGE REHABILITATION AND LONG-TERM ON-RAMP CLOSURE

LOS ANGELES COUNTY - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will demolish and reconstruct a damaged portion of the Temple Avenue Bridge in the city of Long Beach. This will temporarily close the south bound I-405 on-ramp from east bound Spring Street for the duration of this bridge rehabilitation construction work.

Construction will begin in January and is estimated to be completed by the end of the year. Work will be performed Monday thru Friday 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. and nightly from 9 p.m. - 5 a.m. Traffic on Temple Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Residents may experience delays, noise, vibrations and dust.

Local businesses will remain open throughout the duration of construction.

Detours will be posted.

The contractor on this \$2.5 million project is DW Powell Construction Inc. of Fontana, California. The project is funded through the State Highway and Operations Protection Program (SHOPP).
