The FY 15/16 combined grant amount available statewide is \$9.8 million, and all funding for these grant programs are available on a **statewide, competitive basis**.

Strategic Partnerships Grants - encourage regional agencies to partner with Caltrans to identify and address statewide/interregional transportation deficiencies in the state highway system, strengthen government-to-government coordination, and result in programmed system improvements that achieve the State's overarching goals. Interested sub-recipients may also partner with their regional agencies for this grant.

Sustainable Communities Grants - funds transportation planning to identify and address mobility deficiencies in the multimodal transportation system, encourage stakeholder collaboration, involve active public engagement, integrate Smart Mobility 2010 concepts, and
