Acme Concrete Paving, Inc., dba A C P I, requests that you accept this letter as our official bid protest for Contract Number 03-4M8404 bid on May 7, 2014.

The basis of the protest is the requirement of the California Department of Transportation to list each subcontractor performing work in an amount in excess of 1/2 of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, which ever is greater.

Page 7 of the electronic bid book states the following:

“The bidder must identify each subcontractors performing work in an amount in excess of 1/2 of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater. (Pub Cont Code §et seq.) Complete business name, location, and description of subcontracted work atid submit with the bid. Complete bid item numbers and percentage of bid item subcontracted and submit with the bid, or fax to (916)227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in all areas within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid.”

The initial bid opening data that we downloaded from the internet on May 7, 2014 after the bid opening showed that Diversified Concrete Cutting had a Misc Error. The error message states “Required fields not entered in SubContractor List screen”. Attached please find the initial bid opening data pages one through four. Diversified Concrete Cutting bid information is on page three.

The apparent low bidder Diversified Concrete Cutting did not submit a list of subcontractors or work descriptions to be performed by others with there bid. Attached is a copy the bid summary. Note that Diversified Concrete Cuttings listed “NONE” for both name, address and description of portions of work subcontracted. Furthermore, either


with the bid or within 24 hours Diversified Concrete Cutting is required to submit complete bid items numbers and percentages. Attached is a copy of Diversified Concrete Cuttings bid book no additional information has been submitted within the specified time frame. As per the above requirements failure to provide complete information in all areas within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid.



To Whom it May Concern,

Acme Concrete Paving, Inc., dba A C P I, requests that you accept this letter with supplemental information as a follow up to our bid protest letter of May 9, 2014, regarding Contract Number 03-4M8404 bid on May 7, 2014.

The basis of the protest is the requirement of the California Department of Transportation to list each subcontractor performing work in an amount in excess of ½ of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater. At the time of our original protest letter Diversified Concrete Cutting had not submitted their CALTRANS BIDDER – DBE – COMMITMENT information. Attached please find a copy for reference of Diversified Concrete Cutting DBE commitment information.

We would like to bring to your attention two Contractors that are listed for DBE commitment that were not listed by Diversified Concrete Cutting in their subcontractor list at bid time.

Contractor No. 1 is Northern Industrial Electric. Northern Industrial Electric scope of work includes Bid Item No. 22, 23, and 24. This work is described as the Weigh Station System, Weather Info System and Traffic System. Total amount bid for this work is \$246,820.00 or 4.01% of the contract amount. Northern Industrial Electric scope of work is in excess of ½ of 1 percent of the total bid therefore Diversified Concrete Cutting is required to list them at bid time. Northern Industrial Electric scope of work is on page six of the attachment. The scope includes both supply and installation of the items which intern makes them a true subcontractor on the project. Furthermore, Northern Industrial Electric DBE Certificate indicates that they are approved under NAICS Code 238210 Electrical Contractors. The certificate does not allow Northern Industrial Electric to be considered a supplier. Therefore Northern Industrial Electric should not be allowed as a subcontractor on the job, and their quote should not count towards Diversified's DBE participation goals.

Contractor No. 2 is Lindy's Cold Planing. Lindy's Cold Planing scope of work includes Bid Item No. 8. The scope of the work is described as Cold Plane Rental. Diversified Concrete Cutting is contracting an estimated \$134,400.00 of the contract to Lindy's. This equates to 2.18% of the contract amount. Lindy's Cold Planing scope of work is in excess of ½ of 1 percent of the total bid therefore Diversified Concrete Cutting is required to list them at bid time. Lindy's Cold Planing scope of work is on page twenty of the attachment. Lindy's Cold Planing is supplying one operator per rental terms and condition number one, which make them a subcontractor on the project. Furthermore, page two of Lindy's Cold Planing scope references them as a subcontractor on conditions 8, 9, and 16, and on their quote they are showing their contractors license # A 754500. Lindy's Cold Planing DBE Certificate indicates that they are approved under NAICS Code 237310 Highway, Street, and Bridge Construction and 238910 Site Preparation Contractors. Lindy's is not approved as a rental company the Work Code for Heavy Equipment Rental is C9908. Attached please find the work codes that Lindy's is approved for and note they are not approved for C9908, furthermore the do not have a resellers permit. Therefore Lindy's Cold Planning should not be allowed as a subcontractor on the job, and their quote should not count towards Diversified'd DBE participation goals.

As mentioned in our previous correspondence, page 7 of the electronic bid book states the following:

"The bidder must identify each subcontractors performing work in an amount in excess of ½ of 1 percent of the total bid or \$10,000, whichever is greater. (Pub Cont Code §et seq.) Complete business name, location, and description of subcontracted work and submit with the bid. Complete bid item numbers and percentage of bid item subcontracted and submit with the bid, or fax to(916)227-6282 within 24 hours after the bid opening. Failure to provide complete information in all areas within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid."

The apparent low bidder Diversified Concrete Cutting did not submit a list of subcontractors or work descriptions to be performed by others with their bid. As per the above requirements failure to provide complete information in all areas within the time specified will result in a nonresponsive bid.

Diversified Concrete Cutting listed subcontractors for their DBE commitment. These subcontractor's are required to be listed at bid time or within 24 hours after bid opening. The inconsistency between the required subcontractors list at the time of bid and the filed DBE commitment, makes Diversified Concrete paving non compliant with the 5% DBE requirement established in the contract. We would finally like to point out that Diversified Concrete Paving did not file any DBE good faith effort documentation. In fact within their DBE proposal they show \$0 / TBD on Simplex Construction Supply. Which clearly shows their lack of good faith effort to meet the required 5% DBE goal.


